# THE THIRD STOP OF THE 2015-2016 ICE CROSS DOWNHILL WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

Finland hosts the third Red Bull Crashed Ice race of 2015-2016. The event will be held on the 630-metre-long permanent natural ice cross downhill track at the Laajis Ski Resort. The track is located in Jyväskylä, approximately 250 kilometers from the capital of Helsinki.

We promise you a great event and we are excited to be your hosts. Now that You are all on your way; here are more details about the event.

#### THE COURSE

Red Bull Crashed Ice will move to Jyväskylä – Laajis ski resort for the third stop of the season and will feature the longest track of the history of the sport. Running over 600 meters long with 60 meter vertical drop, the course will integrate the natural elements of the environments to its epic proportions. The track in Jyväskylä will be the only natural ice track of the 2015-2016 season. In general, natural ice tracks tend to be bumpier and invariably more challenging with a greater variation of the ice conditions form the start high up on the mountain to finish line down in the valley than the more perfect and consistent ice conditions throughout created by cooling systems that are buried beneath the artificial ice tracks.

# Where is the airport located?

There are two ways to get to Jyväskylä, which is located 250km from the Helsinki Capital:

- 1. Jyväskylä is easily accessible by air. The airport is located in Tikkakoski, about 23 kilometres from the center of Jyväskylä. From Tikkakoski airport to the city: Taxis operating in the Jyväskylä region wait in front of the airport when flights arrive. There is a taxi phone at the terminal entrance. You can use it to request a taxi when necessary. There are no regular bus connections from the airport to the city center.
- 2. Fly into the Helsinki International Airport (HEL) Jyväskylä is easily accessible by train from the Helsinki airport. The train leaves from the airport and will take you to Jyväskylä city center (takes about 3,5 hours, depending on which train you are taking).

# Where do I register?

Registration is located in the lobby of Spa Hotel Rantasipi Laajavuori. Registration is open on Thursday from 9am to 14pm.

## Do I need to drop off my jersey?

All athletes who **do NOT** have badges attached to their jersey shall drop off their jerseys when they register at the hotel. See above for registration location and open hours. You can pick up your jersey at the athletes area after the badges have been attached.

#### Where do I eat?

Breakfast is served daily at the Spa Hotel Rantasipi Laajavuori for hotel guests. Lunch and dinner will be served at the venue from Thursday to Saturday. You must have your credentials (lanyards) with you at all times to gain access to athlete meals and areas on site.

## If there are changes to the schedule - where do I look?

There will be an information desk in the athlete lounge. Please check this throughout the weekend for updates to the schedule.

#### Where is the after party?

The legendary after party will be held on Saturday at Club Escape 10pm – 4am. You must be 18 and have a valid event accreditation to enter the party!

There is a location at the venue where you can purchase Official Crashed Ice merchandise. Quantities are limited so please purchase early.

## Where can I get my skates sharpened?

Skate sharpening is free and will be available in the athlete area.

## Do I have to pay taxes for the prize money?
